EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19

EXTENSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 11 SUSPENSION OF TARIFF ON RICE

WHEREAS, the Government constituted a Committee to examine the causes of increases in the price of strategic commodities and that the Committee recommended to Government corrective measures to be taken;

WHEREAS, considering the Committee's recommendation, the Government instituted certain corrective measures which were implemented in Executive Order #11, including the suspension of import tariff on rice, the country's staple;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of the Executive Power vested in the President by the Constitution, the President issued executive order #11 in the public interest, to correct this particular situation which cannot await the lengthy legislative process run its course;

NOW THEREFORE, the Government of Liberia in its desire to continue bringing relief to the public hereby extends executive order #11, suspending the import tariff on rice as classified under tariff Nos. 1006.30.00 (in packing of more than 5kg or in bulk); 1006.30.00 (in packing of at least 5kg); and 1006.40.00 (broken rice) under the Revenue Code of Liberia Act 2000 with immediate effect.

This Executive Order shall take effect on the 3^{rd} day of March A.D. 2009.
