President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf has congratulated all Muslims for successfully concluding the holy month of Ramadan, one of the fundamental pillars in the Islamic faith. She made the assertion when she addressed Muslims at the end of the holy month of Ramadan earlier today.

She thanked all Muslims for keeping the Nation in their prayers during those challenging moments of the last 30 days of fast, isolation and intimate supplications to the creator, Allah; noting that all Liberians are grateful for their commitment to relentlessly put forth to Allah our numerous challenges – thus asking for His wisdom and guidance to lead and protect this nation.
