- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today attended a special event organized by the W.V.S. Tubman University Foundation and the Marylanders for Progress (MFP) in Washington, D.C. USA to raise funds for a project both organizations are spearheading to construct a state of the art electronic library and learning center at the W.V.S. Tubman University (TU) in Maryland County.

At the well-attended and impressive event, President Sirleaf said that construction of the state of the art electronic library will stimulate ongoing efforts to expand Liberia's educational reform with technology at the core.

President Sirleaf recalled that Dr. Elizabeth Russell, President of Tubman University, took a virtually non-functional technical college suffering from the ruins of the war and neglect and in three years has turned it into the best higher education institution in the country.

She thanked all well-meaning philanthropists, charitable institutions, and friends of Liberia for joining in support of this worthy project.
