HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES - Friday, September 25, 2015

President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today addressed the High-Level Plenary Meeting of the UN General Assembly where they had gathered to adopt the Sustainable Development Goals as the new global agenda to replace the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) at the end of 2015.

She told global leaders that the successful implementation of the 2030 Development Agenda will depend largely on the concrete measures taken at the sub-national, national, regional and global levels.

The Liberian leader told global leaders that the 2030 Agenda is probably the most universal agenda the world has ever put together because every country, every segment of society was involved.

She argued that the 2030 Agenda contains a collective ambition to transform the world and ensure that every person lives to their fullest potential in a safe sustainable social environment.

The Liberian leader made the remarks at a High-Level reception to launch an initiative in support of the implementation of Agenda 2030 and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
