

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES – Wednesday, November 2, 2016

- Cabinet has carefully assessed and analyzed the country's current economic outlook while mandating austerity measures that seek to address emerging economic challenges. Finance and Development Planning Minister, Boima Kamara, provided a holistic reflection of Liberia's existing economic outlook based on the hindsight of the Economic Management Team, obtaining challenges and advance realistic recommendations aimed at economic diversification for value addition. The body also received substantive overview specific to revenue intake, how likely projections particularly in the agriculture and manufacturing sectors, once explored could lead to improved prospects for the national envelope.
