President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today chaired the First National Water Resources and Sanitation Board Meeting at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The Liberian leader, speaking at the Board Meeting challenged the actors of the sector to consolidate their individual efforts into a holistic way to achieve the goal of actually delivering water, sanitation and hygiene services to all spheres of the society, including rural and urban communities.

She outlined the different government institutions that have responsibility for water, sanitation and hygiene issues and stressed the need for effective collaboration, coordination and cooperation among them to help enhance the curtailing of the visible fragmentation in the sector.

The Liberian leader, notwithstanding, commended the various Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) and donor partners in the sector for complementing Government's efforts of providing water, sanitation and hygiene services to the Liberian people and called on them to do more, but in a consolidated manner.
