➤ President Sirleaf, early this morning, visited the John F. Kennedy Medical Center where she was met on arrival by the Center's Administrator, Dr. Wannie Scott McDonald. She was taken on a guided tour of the medical center to see, first hand, reconstruction and the upgrading of the facility currently taking place there. She toured the second, third and fourth floors of the medical center as well as other parts of the out-patient department including a dry-run of the triage put in place at the side entrance of the compound to screen patients who visit the hospital for treatment and to extract those patients who might have Ebola symptoms.

At the end of the visit, the Liberian leader commended the chief administrator, chief medical officer, doctors and staff at the John F. Kennedy Medical Center for the service they're rendering the Liberian people and said she was very impressed with the improvements being made at the referral and teaching hospital.
