## Highlights of the President's Daily Activities Monday, November 3, 2014

President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf received the Letters of Credence from the new Ambassadors Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Kingdoms of Netherlands and Denmark accredited near Monrovia, His Excellency Mr. Hans Docter and Her Excellency Ms. Margit Thomsen, respectively. The two Ambassadors are resident in Accra, Ghana.

The Liberian leader, while receiving the Dutch and Danish Ambassadors at separate ceremonies at her Foreign Ministry office expressed appreciation on behalf of the Liberian Government and people for their distinctive roles in trying to contain the further spread of the deadly Ebola virus disease and for previous developmental support to the country.

President Sirleaf reflected on the country's relations with the two European nations which dates as far back as the 1800s, expressing regret that the relations were interrupted due to the Liberia's civil conflict. She also highlighted the roles played by the both countries in ending Liberia's civil war and in the reconstruction of the post-conflict nation.
