HIGHLIGHTS OF THE PRESIDENT'S DAILY ACTIVITIES - WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2015

➤ President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today held a Cabinet meeting and at the end, critical decisions were endorsed amid further consultations. Among the decisions endorsed were the post-2015 Development Agenda, the Ministry of Education's proposed Mobile Money Payment System for Rural Teachers and the formation of President's Ebola Recovery Committee (PERAC) based upon the recommendation included in the government's Economic Stabilization and Recovery Plan (ESRP) as a Coordinating Working Group to ensure timely and effective delivery of all key cum strategic projects under the ESRP to be implemented within the next 24 months.

Regarding Labor Force & Human Rights Survey, Cabinet reviewed and requested additional consultations that will ensure the realistic feasibility and practicality of the survey remain. Once completed, the appropriate actors would revert to cabinet.

On the question of the Ministry of Health proposal for increment in the fees of Birth Certificate and Yellow Book, Cabinet concluded that the Ministry goes back and conduct appropriate due diligence that will improve quality in service that is matched by the proposed increase in fees and subsequently bring back the proposal for scrutiny.
