- President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf chaired a Cabinet Meeting today at her temporary offices at the Foreign Ministry.
- Later in the evening, President Sirleaf attended an honoring ceremony and farewell reception for the head of mission and the medical team of the African Union Support to the Ebola Outbreak in West Africa (AU-ASEOWA) hosted by the Ministries of Foreign Affairs and Health at the C. Cecil Dennis Auditorium of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

In a special statement of appreciation, she said Liberians owe the AU-ASEOWA a debt of gratitude as the medical team came at the time they were most needed in the fight against the Ebola virus disease.

The Liberian leader said their arrival here brought inspiration to health workers who were overwhelmed by the disease.
