

Highlights of the President's Daily Activities

Wednesday, November 26, 2014

- In continuation of her visits to various Ebola Treatment Centers in and around Monrovia, President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf today visited the 96-bed Alpha OAU Ebola Treatment Center in Virginia and the 100-bed Island Clinic Ebola Treatment Center near the St. Paul's Bridge, Bushrod Island to assess conditions there and to thank healthcare worker, partners, and volunteers for their services to the country especially in the fight against the Ebola virus disease.

The Liberian leader also stopped over at the new site of the Ma Juah Market to inspect ongoing renovation work there. Marketers at the Ma Juah Market in Vai Town are to shortly relocate to a more spacious and better equipped venue in Old Kru Town on the UN Drive, Waterside.

- Later today, President Sirleaf met with the leadership of the Inter-Religious Council during which they discussed issues of national concern.
